• Trees/Lawn Care. Storm cleanup is ongoing. U City is in our subdivision this week. Progress is limited due to maintenance issues. Crews may pass over larger debris but will come back to pick it up when the "claw" truck is repaired.

Capital Improvements.

- Streets. Street construction project timeline is pending we do not have the dates yet from the contractor. As a reminder, the scope of work for 2023 repairs includes full reconstruction of sections of 7300 Princeton, 7300 Cornell, and 7100 Princeton identified as "failed" on the 2022 H&S Assessment. A multi-year plan is being developed to address other streets. The budget for 2023 street projects including project management costs is ~\$270,000.
- **Sidewalks.** Priority repairs on Tulane and Stanford to be combined with storm related sidewalk repairs. Project proposal was signed but weather has hampered the contractor from scheduling the work. The earliest we expect to see crews here is after Labor Day. **The budget for 2023 sidewalk projects is ~\$15,000.**

Other.

- Street deterioration at Stanford & Pennsylvania. Trustees are working with U City and MSD to determine the cause and plan to repair. No further updates yet.
- Deep pothole on 7100 Tulane. Residents are urged to take caution driving on the 7100 block of Tulane. Trustees have tried to block the hole in the road with a sawhorse. Repairs are dependent on the homeowner as they relate to a sewer lateral leak.

Old Business. Ms Allmon of 7133 Tulane was updated on her sidewalk repair (part of the sidewalk project above).

- **Trustee candidate.** Trustee elections are in April each year. Now is the time to join us at the monthly meetings to learn more about the role of trustee.

New Business.

- Ms. Allmon of 7133 Tulane asked about additional sidewalk repairs and how the trustees
 prioritize capital improvements. Trustees will consider a capital improvement project for
 sidewalks as we continue working on the 5 year plan with Horner & Shiffren.
- Ms Lewis of 825 Midland noted several updates needed on the website which the website team will take into consideration while creating the new website.
