## **Trees/Forest Management.**

- Annual Maintenance continues. Ash and locusts plus seasonal (tasks that must be done prior to leaves falling).
  - We pay Droege per job (it is not a flat fee)
  - o In October will plan for Spring/Summer 2025 priorities
  - o In the Spring, arborist does a walk through to assess any new damage from Winter
  - o Work with arborist to batch maintenance and reduce costs
  - o To make the canopy "perfect" would be over \$200,000
- Find "the list" on the website under Trees
- Sapling requests for planting next spring are due by 1 October. Complete the <u>Sapling Request</u> form which is also posted on the website under Trees. (If you have trouble accessing the form, please email us your request).
  - Each new sapling is about \$900 (including labor)

• Budget \$74,214

## Capital Improvements.

- Streets. 2024 street project ongoing. Estimated completion date 18 Sep.
  - Curbs and gutters in repaired sections were approved by Horner and Shiffren in the engineering plans
  - Please continue to submit problem areas to the trustees for awareness
  - o Dan is working on a sideway assessment and is aiming to be done by November
- Potholes. Area at Colgate and Vanderbilt patched
  - o Thanks to Dan for doing the patching

### **Unfinished Business.**

- Assessment raise.
  - Last year's increase in the special assessment was announced as Part 1 of a 2-part increase. Trustees will decide on Part 2 in October. Estimated Part 2 increase is \$3/ft which is an additional ~\$15/month for the average 60 ft lot.
  - Lot owners have opportunities to discuss with Trustees this summer and early fall.
  - Trustees had a tentative vote to approve \$3/ft raise. Further communications will be sent in the yearly bill
  - Residents will be able to pay in two installments to ease the pain of the cost increase

#### **New Business.**

- Dennis has tentatively volunteered to form a subcommittee to do "welcome wagon" services to welcome new neighbors and let them know about UP policies/responsibilities
- Kellie McCoy announced she discussed stepping down with the Trustees and they accepted her resignation on 13 Sep with an effective date of 1 Oct. Kellie's transition plan includes:
  - o 2024 street project completed 3 years remain in current capital improvement plan
  - o Draft 2025 budget
  - Meeting prep support through November

- o Meeting with arborist to plan winter and early spring tree maintenance
- o The plan for replacing Kellie will be announced after 1 Oct
- Mary made a suggestion of following the Heights model of having intern-like or advisory board members
- Monthly meetings thru end of 2024. Saturday listening sessions are 2 hour blocks for residents to stop by and meet the Trustees or ask questions. There will be no formal meeting but updated report handouts will be available.
