



PERMIT APPLICATION FOR FENCE APPROVAL

No fence may be built or replaced on the side or rear property lines of any lot without the written approval of at least two University Park Trustees. The Trustees will neither consider nor approve any fence application until this form, together with a site plan showing the fence location attached as “Exhibit A” and a drawing of the proposed fence as “Exhibit B” has been submitted. Acceptable Site Plans include a boundary survey or a subdivision plat. In addition, Trustees require that all fence construction abide by the University City permit process.
